Italian Art Songs: Any Italian art song such as are found in:

- 24 Italian Songs (Schirmer)
- 26 Italian Songs (Alfred)
- 28 Italian Songs (Alfred)
- Arie Antiche (Ricordi)
- Classic Italian Songs (Ditson)
- L'Aria Barocca (Leyerle)
- Italian Arias of the Baroque and Classic eras (Alfred)

French Chanson: Any French classical song such as are found in:

- 40 French Songs (International)
- Anthology of Modern French Song (Schirmer)
- French Art Song (Ditson)

Songs by individual classical composers such as:

Bizet, Chausson, Debussy, Duparc, Fauré, Gounod, Hahn, Massenet, Poulenc, Saint-Saens ...

German Lied: Any German classical song as found in:

- Fifty Selected Songs by Schubert, Schumann, Brahms, Wolf, and Strauss (Schirmer)

Songs by individual German composers such as:

JS Bach, Brahms, Mozart, Schubert, Schumann, Strauss, Wolf ...

Songs in English: Any classical song in English as found in:

- Songs by 22 Americans (Schirmer)
- American Art Songs of the Turn of the Century (Dover)
- Songs by 30 Americans (Ditson)
- A Heritage of 20th Century British Song (Boosey)
- Elizabethan Love Songs (Boosey)

Songs by individual British and American composers such as:

Argento, Copland, Duke, Bernstein, Britten, Dowland, Finzi, Purcell, Quilter, Vaughan Williams, Warlock ...

Art Songs included in song collections such as:

- Soprano Songs (Boosey) also Mezzo Soprano, Alto, Tenor, Baritone, Bass Songs from same series
- The Art Song (Consolidated)

50 Art Songs (Schirmer)
Great Art Songs (Schirmer)

Oratorio: Arias from oratorios or passions such as: Messiah, Elijah,
St. Matthew Passion, Christmas Oratorio ...

Opera: Advanced singers may sing an operatic aria such as an aria
from an opera by: Britten, Bizet, Handel, Monteverdi, Mozart, Puccini,
Verdi ...
