The spouse of a student (F-1) visa holder is NOT permitted to work under any circumstances and is highly limited in coursework s/he may pursue.

Funds may come from any dependable source, including scholarships, fellowships, sponsoring agencies, personal funds, or funds from the student’s family. Documentation of scholarships and fellowships must be in the form of an official award letter from the school or sponsoring agency. Documentation of personal or family funds should be on bank letterhead stationery or in the form of a legal binding affidavit. An I-20 or DS-2019 used to secure a U.S. visa cannot be sent if this section is not completed.
