Requirement: This workshop is a requirement for Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle and High School and Special Education Licensure in Oregon. The workshop is six (6) hours in length and attendance during all six hours is required. A test covering the anti-discrimination laws is administered at the close of the workshop. Passage of the test is required for Oregon licensure.

Fee: **\$40.00** for persons who are not full-time (taking more than six (6) hours of credit during the term.) **\$20.00** for persons who are currently enrolled in a SOU School of Education Licensing program. Fee is paid at the conclusion of the workshop.

Location: All sessions will be held on the SOU campus in Ashland, Oregon. A map (on the reverse of this notice) of the campus and room assignment will be included in your pre-registration packet.

Registration and Advanced Reading Materials: Pre-registration is required since enrollees will be mailed important reading materials/assignments prior to the workshop date.
