## Part II. Plan for Success

To improve your chances for an academic rebound, take time to think through and plan your next term at SOU by completing this “Plan for Success.” Work with your advisor, the schedule of classes, and the university catalog, and discuss the combinations and timing of courses that will best suit your academic goals, needs, and limitations. In planning for the future, remember the following:

Students on academic probation who earn a term GPA of at least 2.0 but have an SOU cumulative GPA of less than 2.0 will remain on academic probation.

Students on academic probation who earn a term GPA of less than 2.0 will be placed on academic suspension.

Students who fail to earn at least 50 percent of the attempted hours in four consecutively enrolled terms in which they attempted a minimum of six hours each term will be placed on academic suspension.

Academic suspension is recorded on the student’s academic record. Students who are academically suspended are denied all the privileges of the Institution and of all organizations in any way connected to it, including University-organized living groups.

- It is highly recommended that you take no more than 13 credits until your term your SOU cumulative GPA are well above 2.0.
- Consider completing your General Education requirements.
- The “Plan for Success” does not guarantee you a place in the proposed classes. Check with the “Open Class List” at [www.sou.edu/sis](http://www.sou.edu/sis). You may want to discuss alternative plans depending on course availability.
