## NOTES ABOUT SCHOLARSHIP AUDITIONS:

- In order to audition for a scholarship you must have applied for admission to SOU. If you have not applied, please visit: <http://www.sou.edu/admissions/application/>
- To be awarded a scholarship, you must have been admitted to SOU. If you are selected to receive a scholarship, other conditions will be explained in the award letter.
- Make sure your scholarship application is complete. Include anything you feel is pertinent regarding your accomplishments on an additional sheet of paper.
- Auditions will take place between 10 am and 3 pm. You will be notified by email of your exact audition time by February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Please note any time constraints on the application.
- Your audition piece should be one that displays your performance talents. It should contain a variety of styles that demonstrate your phrasing and technique. **Length of audition piece should be approximately 5 minutes.**
- Students are encouraged to bring their own accompanist.
- If you are unable to audition in person you are welcome to send a DVD recording.
- A letter of recommendation from your music teacher must accompany your recording.
- Recordings must be received by the deadline date of January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2010, to be considered in our scholarship deliberations.
- Scholarship decisions will be made by the scholarship committee after the final audition date and all applicants will be notified by mid April.
