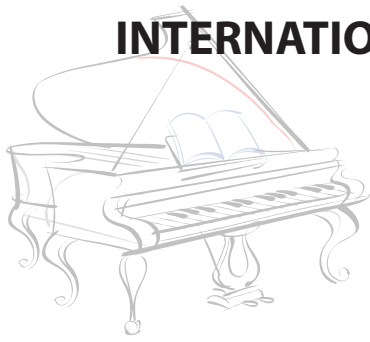

GENERAL INFORMATION

Application Materials: A short biography, your resume, and a repertoire list.

Minimum/Maximum Age or Level of Study: The minimum age limit is 11 years old. The IPI is for serious piano students only. All applicants should be near the intermediate or advanced level of playing. Students or auditors should be able to concentrate and stay focused during master classes and lectures.

Out of town applicants: Please call before making airline reservations to confirm that arrival and departure times will allow participation in all institute activities. Institute activities will begin on Monday August 3rd, 2009 and end on Saturday August 8th, 2009. All out of town applicants will need to take care of all outside expenses such as renting a car, paying for local lodging, meals, etc.

Refund policy: If participants withdraw less than 60 days prior to the institute for any reason, no refunds are possible. Cancellations made more than 60 days before the program will receive a 50% refund.

Special activities: Institute participants have the option of participating in additional activities (such as a Britt performance or theater production) ranging in price from \$30-50. Information will be provided to students upon acceptance.

FEES

Tuition: The Piano Institute is being held in a higher education facility. Fees are based on operating costs. Total tuition cost is \$250, total audit cost is \$150, including application fee. When a student is accepted they will pay the remainder of their tuition minus the application fee.
