NOTE: The following requirements have been proposed for students admitted beginning in fall, 2005. These requirements are tentative until they receive final approval by the Oregon University System. Please consult with your academic advisor before planning your course selection.

Music Instruction Certificate. This certificate is for students who wish to become general music teachers, primary or secondary choral or band instructors. Completion of this certificate prepares students for entry to the Master of Teaching degree and certification to teach in the state of Oregon. In addition to the 51 credit hours of music core required for the BA/BS degree, students will complete the following music instruction courses. Students seeking a music instruction certificate will have a total of 90 credits of music courses.
