Dear Parents:

Welcome to the *new KIDS U!* We've planned exciting hands-on activities to increase your child's love of learning and adventure. KIDS U classes run Monday through Friday from 10:00 am to noon and/or 1:00 to 3:00 pm.

All Students:

Be sure your child dresses appropriately for class activities and the weather. If it looks like rain, have your child bring rain-repellent clothing or an umbrella. **All students must wear closed-toe shoes.** There is no eating allowed in the classrooms; students are encouraged to bring water bottles to class.

Students are expected to conduct themselves **courteously** and in a manner that **respects the rights of fellow students, instructors and counselors.** Inappropriate behavior will be handled on an individual basis and could involve a warning, phone call to parents, or being asked to leave the program.

We have enclosed a **Medical and Photo Release Form** for all students. Parents must complete this and return it to us on the **first** day of class. If your child is not participating in the supervised lunch, then you must take your child directly to their class and pick them up after their class.

Full Day Students Participating in Supervised Lunch:

If your child is attending KIDS U for the full day (morning and afternoon classes), a FREE supervised lunch period from 12:00-1:00 pm is available. Students in the supervised lunch period will need to bring a brown bag lunch to eat in the Campbell Center. Students will be escorted from their morning classes to lunch and then to their afternoon class. If you do not fill out the enclosed registration from indicating you would like us to pick up your child for lunch, then you are responsible for picking them up from their morning class and returning them to their afternoon class.

Please plan on attending the Supervised Lunch orientation and registration at 9:00 am each Monday of KIDS U.
