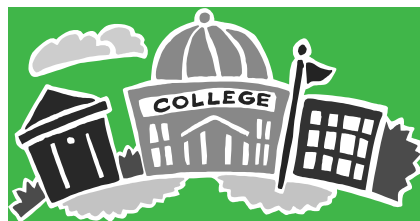

How Much Do I Pay?

Summer Start tuition is \$50 per credit plus SOU student fees. Most academic courses are offered for three or four credits. Summer Start students are limited to 12 credits.

Bills are mailed in mid-June requesting immediate payment.
